SENIOR COACH POSITION 2022/23 SEASON

Research Eltham Collegians Cricket Club ("RECCC") is a proud club celebrating a long history extending to over 60 years in season 2022/23.

Following the redevelopment to our home clubrooms at Research Park where we now provide excellent facilities, and with additional grounds and facilities available as a result of our relationship with Eltham College, we continue to experience growth at all levels, and are now looking for a Senior Coach to lead the next stage of our cricket growth.

Affiliated with the Diamond Valley Cricket Association ("DVCA") we currently field 6 senior teams including the first XI who compete in Barclay Shield.

The First XI have enjoyed recent premierships successes with Money Shield and Mash Shield Premierships in seasons 20-21, and 18-19, and we have continuing aspirations to further build and to grow both on field and off field.

The club has a strong junior program, is a known leader in girls' cricket within the DVCA and fields 11 sides across our junior, girls, all abilities, and women in cricket teams. The club also has more than 30 juniors within its Blasters program.

Position Available - Non-Playing Coach/Playing Coach

The club will consider applicants who may wish to be considered for either a non-playing Senior coach or a playing Senior coach position.

We will provide support to the Senior Coach via a club-based network of support which will include a net captain, a chairman of selectors, specific skill-based assistants supported by a self-directed senior playing group.
