<b>Training</b>	<p><b>Communication skills</b> – articulate in addressing club playing list as well as interpersonal and leadership skills necessary to communicate on an individual basis.</p> <p><b>Training organisation</b> – be able to plan, delegate and coordinate structured training sessions on a weekly basis.</p> <p>Work with a panel of assistant and developing coaches to ensure all team are provided support and development of their cricket.</p> <p><b>Coaching/Individual player development</b> – ability to impart your skills, knowledge and experience to enhance the individual development of a young playing list.</p> <p>We would be looking for applicants to be able to demonstrate how they would implement training plans and provide an environment where individuals can improve parts of their game.</p>
